The AWSC Spring Convention was held on March 25<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> in Green Bay. Several club members were able to attend. The General Session Meeting was held on Saturday morning and included excellent guest speakers. Preston Cole, Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, spoke about the need to reduce snowmobile accidents in Wisconsin. Most accidents are the result of drinking and or driving too fast. He has funds to use for promoting safety and would like to hear our ideas on how to get the word out. Jillian Steffes, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Grant Manager, spoke about grant application for special projects and how are trails are funded through registration, gas tax and trail pass funds. Andrew Nussbaum, Wisconsin Department of Tourism, spoke about promoting the State of Wisconsin. There is a new Wisconsin slogan: Here's to those who Wisconsin! He also touched on how important our landowners are to our sport. Please make sure to thank a landowner whenever possible and always respect the land they allow us to use for our trails. It was exciting to see these speakers supporting snowmobiling in Wisconsin.

# Adams County Snowmobile Association March 3, 2022 Cedar Shack

The March 3, 2022 meeting of the Adams County Snowmobile Association was called to order at 7:00pm by President Gordy Carlson. There were 22 members present. All clubs were represented except Coloma, Grand Marsh and New Haven. The Secretary read the minutes from the February 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting. There were no changes. A motion to accept was made by Dennis Kulwicki and seconded by Bryan Meyer. All in favor, motion carries. The **Treasurer** was not in attendance, but it was reported that no checks had been written, so the balance remains at \$5831.38.

**Sheriff's report:** Caleb reported that second safety class had 13 kids who passed. There will be an ATV/UTV safety class the end of March, the 22<sup>nd</sup> from 5-7 and the 26<sup>th</sup> from 9-3. It seems that people from out of our county have been attending these classes, so they will be advertising it differently. He reported that two different through the ice incidents had happened in the same place.

County Director report: Gary was not there, so Kathy read what he sent. The spring convention will be in Green Bay on March 25-27. He reminded everyone that voting for the AWSC executive board will be taking place. He also said that a vote on the changes to the AWSC by-laws to address the issue of being able to continue business during a pandemic will happen. There are other changes that are listed on the AWSC website. Every club's membership chair should have received a voting delegate form from the AWAC office. These need to get back to the office by March 10<sup>th</sup> with the names of the voting delegates for your club. If you or your club have any questions or concerns that you would like him to bring up at the convention, let him know.


