
The grooming equipment will be checked over and ready to go as soon as we have the much needed gold that mother nature can provide us. Pray for snow so we can get this year off to good start.



ZERO ALCOHOL KEEPS YOU SAFE ON THE TRAIL

Drinking alcohol before snowmobiling or during your ride slows your reactions, impairs your judgment, and is a leading contributor to snowmobiling deaths. Last winter, alcohol was involved in 70 percent of the 23 snowmobiling fatalities.

Join DNR in the international zero alcohol campaign that urges every snowmobiler to take personal responsibility for reducing alcohol-related crashes. Wisconsin conservation wardens will be handing out zero alcohol stickers to snowmobilers and asking you to display it.

Here's what you can do to help:

- Display the sticker on your helmet, snowmobile, trailer, or vehicle.
- Choose to be 100 percent alcohol-free until after your ride is over and you're safely home.
- Commit to riding only with other snowmobilers who are alcohol-free.

Annual Membership Renewal

Rome Sno-Bandit & AWSC memberships both expire on June 30th annually. We process membership with the AWSC monthly in the summer and weekly in winter

to minimize processing fees. We encourage you to renew your membership in July or August to avoid delays in receiving your trail pass. Membership applications can be found on our website along with trail pass information.

If you provide your email address with your membership application, you will receive an email from the AWSC confirming your membership has been processed. This email will include your membership number and directions for ordering your trail pass.

You can also find your AWSC Membership number on the mailing label of your WSN Magazine or at <u>https://www.awsc.org/About-Us/Member-Lookup</u>. Your membership number never changes.

Lori Heideman, AWSC Vice President, spoke about how our club is now nominated for National Snowmobile Club of the Year and potentially International Snowmobile Club of the Year. National awards will be announced in the spring and the winners will be presented with the award at International Snowmobile Congress in June in Iowa.

Secretary's Report

There were no changes to the Secretary's report. A motion was made by Willy Sandfox to accept the report as it was presented in the newsletter. Bob Sweet seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report

Cathy Steinke reported on the checking & savings account balances. Jim Fisher made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Kathy Halverson seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Trail Boss Report - Larry Halverson

Thank you to the 54 people that volunteer to brush and sign trails today. There are several trail changes this year due to things changing in our area. With Jerry & Larry being involved with the Town of Rome, they are able to know about these changes early. If you hear of any possible land sales on our trail system, please let Larry know ASAP so he can work with the landowner. We have new equipment for grooming our trails this season with the New Holland tractor that will pull the drag and the McCormick that will be used for driveway clean up and for cutting brush with the new sickle bar attachment. Thank you to Larry, Gary Gevers, Jeff Hoffmann and John Steinke for work working on the trails this past week. The section around the Sand Valley Lido course is very nice. Sand Valley has been good to us and the community. We need to thank them in as many ways as we can. More maps are being printed. We need to tell people about Priztls being closed for the winter and no fuel being available in our area. Gas is available at the Lure and Big Horn Sports Store but there are no pay at the pump options at either place. Trails will not be signed to Pritzls this year. President Tom Warner and the membership thanked Jerry Wiessinger and Larry Halverson for all the work they have done on our trail. It has been a challenging year.

Social Committee Report

A sympathy card was sent to Chris Johnson & Tim Kane for the loss of Tim's Mother. A card needs to be sent out to the family of Linda Ebbe who passed away in October. Linda was a founding member of the club and the 1st female DNR Snowmobile Safety Instructor in the State of Wisconsin. Decorating the corner in front of the Town Hall and setting up the Christmas trees for people to decorate will take place on November 24th at 10:00 am. 12 trees have been purchased. Jerry is in need of three tree judges for Friday afternoon, December 3rd.

The Sno-bandits handed out 240 bags of candy at the Rome Halloween drive thru. Kathy Halverson wore the club mascot costume.

There are 15 rooms booked for the club trip in St Germain at the end of January. Book your rooms in the next couple weeks if you plan to attend as they will be releasing the rooms soon. 
