Ice Riding Safety Tips

Drowning is one of the leading causes of snowmobile fatalities. Wherever possible, avoid riding on frozen lakes and rivers because ice conditions are never guaranteed. Ice conditions can change in a period of several hours. If you must cross ice, stay on the packed or marked trail. Don't stop until you reach shore. If you hit slush, don't let off the throttle. If you are following someone who hits slush, veer off to make your own path. If you must travel over lakes and rivers then consider using a buoyant snowmobile suit which will help you reach the closest ice surface. Also consider carrying a set of picks that will help you grip the edge of the ice more easily. As a rule of thumb, "If you don't know, don't go."

If you do break through the ice, don't panic. Follow these self-rescue tips:

- -Kick vigorously into a horizontal position and swim to the nearest ice edge.
- -Place hands/arms on unbroken ice while kicking hard to propel your body onto the ice, like a seal.
- -Once clear, stay flat and roll away to stronger ice.
- -Stand, keep moving and find shelter fast.

Instructions For Making Ice Claws

- 1) Get two 4" pieces of wooden doweling the size of a broom handle or a little larger. Whatever material you select, it should float in case you drop the claws while struggling.
- 2) Drive a stout nail into one end of each dowel. This should be a hardened 16 penny or larger concrete nail.
- 3) Use a file to sharpen the nail heads to a point.
- 4) Drill a hole into the dowels (in the end opposite the nail) and tie a length of strong cord through the hole so a pick is on each end "jump-rope" fashion. You may also drill a hole in the ends alongside the nails so the nail on the other pick can nest in the hole, keeping both points covered. Keep the picks in your pocket for quick emergency access if you or a companion does break through.



Secretary's Report

There were no changes to the Secretary's report. A motion was made by Kathy Halverson to accept the report as it was presented in the newsletter. Bob Sweet seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report

Trail Boss Report - Larry Halverson

We have snow! A decision was made not to roll the trails because it is going to be 56 degrees on Wednesday and if rolled, people might think the trails are open and ride them. Thank you to DCM Landscaping. They donate 10 hours of time leveling logging areas near Adams Ave & Hwy 73 that were rutted up. Trails are ready to go once we get snow. Governor Evers signed the 40' rule. Make sure you dim your lights when approaching an oncoming vehicle or snowmobile. Gary Gevers, Susan Krueger and Larry & Kathy Halverson marked changes on our trail maps. The new solar plant had damage over the deer season from trespassers and might shut our trail down to County Sports. We are trying to work this issue out and looking into alternative routes. Sand Valley requested the use of our tractor in 2022. This past year they paid us \$13,000 and used it for 28 hours. Gary Gevers made a motion to rent the tractor to Sand Valley in 2022. Brian Palmers seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Social Committee Report

A sympathy card was sent to Gene & Lisa McLellan for the loss of Lisa's Mother and to Brian Palmer for the loss of his Grandfather. Get-well cards were sent to Carl Hasdal, Brian Baker, Nicole Stritesky and Tom Gabriel.

After purchasing cards and donuts, there is a balance of \$78.32 in the kitty. Kathy Halverson made a motion to replenish the kitty with \$200. Suzanne Kostreva seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Activities Report

Bryan Meyer gave a Petenwell Palooza Ice Fisheree update. A volunteer signup sheet was passed around. We are looking for booze donations. Raffle tickets are available. Posters are available to be put up.

Club trip is the last weekend in January. Linda Randall, Suzanne Kostreva, Melissa Rhodes and Lori Heideman will work on activities for the trip.


