Deer Hunting- DNR held zoom meetings to discuss the concerns and safety issues. They educated the hunting group on the conflict with the snowmobile season. AWSC recommended that they replace the Holiday Hunt with a 4-day Antlerless Hunt in October. Also recommended extending the 10-day hunt to a 16-day hunt.

AWSC Memberships- If you supply an email address with your membership application you will receive an email with your membership number and card to print out. AWSC does not share their email list with anyone.

The National Vintage Show will be held in Marshfield at the Fairgrounds August 6-7-8. This will be a big show.

They are working on legislation to eliminate 40ft rule. Gong to clean up wording and will be adding something to include dimming of headlights within 500ft.

Club of the Year Committee is meeting monthly and working on application.


