IF YOU RIDE OUR TRAILS, PLEASE JOIN OUR CLUB!!!

The Rome Sno-Bandit Snowmobile Club was founded in 1978. The club was started by individuals dedicated to the growing sport of snowmobiling. They started the club with one trail and groomed that one trail with nothing more than a homemade drag pulled behind their own snowmobiles. Our club has grown from that single trail. But our dedication has remained the same. Our club's dedication to snowmobiling is only second to our dedication to our family. It is this dedication to snowmobiling and family that our club strives to encourage in all of our events.

The Rome Sno-Bandit Snowmobile Club invites all riders to join our club. Our meetings are held on the 2nd Saturday of each month from September thru June. Meetings are held at Trails End Bar and Grill (official home of the Sno-Bandits) at the corner of Alpine Drive and 15th Ave. Snowmobile operators born after January 1, 1984 must have a valid safety certificate. Safety courses are available through our club.

The Sno-Bandits groom our trails with two pieces of equipment. We have a John Deere Tractor that pulls a 10' wide Sno-Boss drag. Our other groomer is a Tucker that pulls an 8' wide Sno-Boss drag. Winter grooming is done several times a week depending on snow conditions. Our trails include 21.9 miles of state funded trails and 12 miles of local trails. We are located in the northwest corner of Adams County and also have trails in southern Wood County.

Our winter trails are prepared in the fall by removing the downed trees from summer storms, and then brushed by hand. Our biggest work day is the second Saturday of November and is followed by our famous chili dump at the town hall. If necessary, we try to grade out the ruts. All of this is done by volunteer labor and usually totals over 500 hours per year. The Sno-Bandits are committed to providing safe, responsible snowmobile riding. Our trails and routes cross many different public and private lands. Failure to follow the rules by 'rogue riders', jeopardizes our trail system.

If you are an avid snowmobiler and never have belonged to a club, you are not supporting our sport!! The trail system in Wisconsin is completely maintained by **Volunteers**. Trail funding is only partly funded by state funds. When the state money runs out, trails are maintained by using club money. This money is raised by club members **Volunteering** their time and money to help raise money for our club. A \$25 or \$30 membership is a small price to help keep our trails safe. If you are a club member who has let their membership lapse, update your membership, take note of our activity dates and volunteer an hour or two. By volunteering, you get the satisfaction of knowing that you helped keep our trail system strong for generations to come.

If you are interested in joining our club, please complete this form and send with the proper dues to our club address. We welcome everyone interested in riding snowmobiles in our area. While active participation in club activities is encouraged, it is not necessary to belong to our club. Donations by nonmembers are welcomed.

The Rome Sno-Bandit's annual fundraisers include a Poker Run that runs for 4 weeks starting January 1st, a Classic Car, Bike, and Antique Snowmobile Show the Saturday of Father's Day weekend and hosting the beer and wine tent at the Taste of Rome in July.
