

Nov 6, 2025 ACSA meeting minutes

The ACSA meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm starting with the pledge of allegiance. The secretaries report was approved with a motion by Gordy and Dennis, motion passed. Treasure was absent so no report was read. Dues owed yet from last year are Monroe \$13, New Haven \$27, Oxford \$29, and Coloma \$65.

Directors report: Last year there were 5 ATV/UTV deaths and 1 snowmobile death in water. There were 9 deaths all total involving snowmobiles in WI. and 16 in Michigan. Report traffic counters if you come across any at railroad crossing. The railroad is working on closing crossings. There is a bill in assembly and senate to raise fees, with members paying \$20.00 non members \$50.00, out of state will pay \$70.00. In state registration goes to \$45.00 and out of state to \$75.00 in three years. New snars rates. Apply for county scholarships.

Darren reported that he has snars information sheets. Equipment time also needs labor time. Update faded and non reflective signs.

Steve reported that the powersports show still has bills coming in. The dealers are requesting a 2 day show since it takes a lot of time and effort to get all their stuff there. Looking at the hours of Sat. 9-5 and Sunday 10-4. Dealers need to have special pricing for show days. A TV was suggested for the beer tent. We need an advertising committee so we can reach further out. The decision on a 2 day show will need to be made by June. A Thankyou was received from Miss Snowflake and her sister.

The MS ride was brought up, and a request from the ADS of Adams County was received to donate to their Angle tree for seniors and veterans. Motion by Stacy and Kurt to donate \$200.00 to the Angel tree, Motion passed.
