Message From Trail Boss, Jerry Wiessinger

For those who were not at the June meeting, the membership approved moving forward with the Groomer Shed Completion Project not to exceed \$60,000. This project will take place in the summer of 2024. We will apply for a grant from Visit Rome which could offset some of the cost. We will need a lot of volunteers to help move everything out of the building into storage containers so the concrete floor can be poured, then the ceiling and walls insulated and paneled. Then after the work is completed, everything needs to be moved back in.

I am continuing to be in contact with Savion who is proposing to build the second solar farm in Saratoga. Currently, they have been very willing to work with us to find a new route for the Country Sports trail between Blue Ridge and the north end of the solar farm.

If you have not heard, there is a solar company proposing to build a solar farm on some of the Meteor land in Rome north of Cty D and north of Alpine where the Corridor and Camelot trails are. I think most everyone in Town is opposed to this, but it may be a long-drawn-out legal battle to stop it. At this point it is only in the planning stage with no definite location decided.

The meeting was called to order at 9:08 am with President, Tom Warner, as the chair and 3 officers present. There were 18 members in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Secretary's Report

There were no changes to the Secretary's report. A motion was made by Gary Gevers to accept the report as it was presented in the newsletter. Jerry Wiessinger seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report

Gary Gevers read Cathy Steinke's treasurer's report. He reported on the checking & savings account balances. Scott Murphy made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Jeff Parmeter seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Trails Boss Report

Tractor went in for service last week. Estimate for repairs is \$5,018.00. \$3,200 of that is labor and the rest is for parts. Jerry will get more details. Clutch and fuel line problems. Motion was made by Ted Sorenson to approve the repairs for \$5,018.00. Jeff Parmeter seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried. If the cost goes over this amount, the board must vote to authorize the additional expense.

Bids for improvements to the groomer shed have been received. We would be able to have meetings, heat and the floor would be concrete. The next step after that would be a septic and another building. Jeff Parmeter made a motion to proceed with groomer shed upgrades in the amount of \$60,000 with a 5% overage allowance. Ted Sorenson seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A new garage door opener will be purchased and install this year.


