The ACSA meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm by president Steve MacIntosh. There were 18 members present with 8 clubs represented.

The minutes from the Jan. 2nd meeting were emailed out, so the reading of them was waved. Motion to accept by Bob Spiess and Bryan Meyer, all approved.

The treasurer's report was read by treasurer Lisa Glaeser. Checks were written out for the maps design and printing. Income is still coming in from map ads. Balance is x. Motion to accept by Bob Spiess and Warren Starner, all approved.

County Director Warren Starner reported that there will be a \$5.00 due increase to be voted on at the Spring Convention. Give your vote sheet to Warren if your club rep. is not going to the convention. Members do not need to send in their insurance cards to be covered, only if they want to be contacted. Please get any club activities to Stormy by July 1st, If you want them on the AWSC calendar. You can also give Stormy any events you want in the magazine. Make sure your insurance is up to date and that you are following your raffle ticket license requirements. The money needs to be going to the place listed on the ticket and staying local. Trespassing fine is \$230.00.

Bills voted on were for Warren's hotel stay at the directors meeting, motion to pay by Bob Spiess and John Steinke, and renewing our raffle license, motion to pay by John Steinke and Dennis Kulwicki. All approved.

Darren suggested renewing your snowmobile registration to keep funds going into the maintenance fund even if you are not snowmobiling. Check bridge weight against your equipment weight so you are not damaging your bridges. Please check your trails for trees down. This is maintenance.

Deputy Macfarland reported that there have been 4 fatalities this year so far. Please be careful of frozen water.

Bryan Meyer reported that the Chambers new slogan is Visit Adams County.

Old Business: maps are available, 2 cases per club, and 5 laminated ones per club. Need at least 6 inches of snow to open trails.

April 3rd at 6:00 pm before the regular meeting will be our first Powersports meeting.

Kurt Mikolite talked about the MS ride and thanked us for our donation.

Coloma is having a radar run Feb 15th.

Oxford is having a pancake breakfast Feb 15.

New Business: Need a nomination committee. Dennis, Paul Jaskulski, and Brent York volunteered. Elections are in April. All officers and 1 board member, (Bryans position).

Dennis brought up the possibility of having an AWSC dinner in May. Kurt, Brent and Dennis volunteered to look into this.

Brent volunteered to try and update our Facebook Page (ACS Information) and Bryan will check with Melissa Rhodes.on the web site.

Steve brought up having a Snowmobile Rescue Group, he will be looking into getting this together.

It was suggested to give maps to the police and fire departments. Bent would like a digital file of the map to put into their system.
