Over 700 people attended the AWSC Spring Convention. Bus trips were held along with a trip to Road America. There were issues with the hospitality rooms. Please remember if you attended an AWSC function that you are a representative of our club. Randy Murdock was elected at the new AWSC Vice President. Steve Clark will be the new Treasurer. The by-law changes passed. Each club is now allowed one vote. The Lilly Snowbirds raised money for KAOS and presented them with a check for \$10,000. The silent auction raised \$7,800. 15 scholarships were given out totaling over \$12,000. The winner of the Rome SnoBandits scholarships is Sophia Conuard. She stopped and thanked club members. Raffle tickets are available for \$100 each with a top prize of \$10,000. There were 3 snowmobile deaths in Wisconsin this past season with the average age being 60 years old. ISC will be held June 13th – June 15th in Green Bay.
