Membership fee increase will be discussed with board members and will not happen this year.

Adams County Snowmobile Association Minutes April 3, 2025

The April 3rd 2025 ACSA meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by President Steve MacIntosh. There were 30 members present with 10 clubs represented. The reading of the March 6th meeting minutes was waved as they had been emailed out. Motion to accept by Gordy Carlson and Warren Starner. All approved.

Treasurer Lisa Gleaser read the Treasurer's report. No new activity. Balance of \$ Motion to accept by Jim Krahn and Stacy Wilson. All approved.

Darren was not in attendance but sent a notice for clubs to check their records because the SNARS system was not working Feb.14th. Send him your work hours.

Director Warren reported that the \$5 membership increase passed. Bringing it up to \$17.00 to join the AWSC. Trail pass fee increases have not passed yet. AWSC membership is at 36,904. July 1st is the AWSC calendar raffle cut off for club events. If clubs are thinking about merging with ATV and UTV clubs, Miss Snowflake can help with all the paperwork. There will be a Powersports show at Sunnyview Expo Center on May 2-4 2025.

Bills: Warren requested reimbursement for half of his hotel stay at the convention which comes to \$106.54. Motion to pay by Gordy and Kurt Mikolite, all approved.

Sheriff's report: ATV safety course registration will be held on May 15th for manual pickup and instructions, with the course on May 31st. It will be held at the community center. April 23 is DNR officer training at Wausau. Safety and registration fines were issued during the snowmobile season.

Old Business: The snowmobile rescue group is still a work in progress. Active member dinner will be May 1st. 6:00 pm social hour and 7:00 pm dinner. Motion to approve by Gordy and Todd Stammen, all approved.

New Business: Club dues need to be paid to the county. It is \$1.00 per member. Elections were all unanimous with only incumbents running.

After 3 readings for each position. Gordy and Jim motioned to close elections for President and all approved. President is Steve McIntosh. Jim and Bubba motioned to close elections for Vice president, all approved. Vice President Gordy Carlson. Jim and Gordy motioned to close elections for Secretary, all approved. Secretary is Joy Krahn. Motion to close elections for Treasurer by Gordy and John Steinke, all approved. Treasurer is Lisa Glaeser. Jim and Gordy motioned to close elections for Director, all approved. Director is Bryan Meyer. Warren Starner was reappointed for Adams County Director and John Steinke was reappointed for Adams County Rep. Gordy and Babba motioned to accept the appointments, all approved.

The Powersports show meeting was held before the County meeting. The date for the show is Oct. 4th, 9am to 4pm. Rain date is Oct. 5. Committees are being formed.

On April 12 a UTV/ATV ride, sponsored by Rome Sno-Bandits, will be held at the Lure. On May 10th there will be a poker run at Tipsey Tee sponsored by South Adams Road Runners.
